

**A series of 3 workshops with felt artist Sue Hawkmoon**  
**Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2017 10.30 – 1pm £25pp** Learn how to make a unique felted poppy brooch to wear all year round with **Sue Hawkmoon** from merino wool using the wet felting technique and using beads or buttons for the centre. One complete poppy will be made and if time allows we may also make another.

**Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2017 10.30 – 3.30pm £45pp** **Felted pictures workshop with Sue Hawkmoon.** Learn how to make two unique felted pictures using beautiful merino wools and silk fibres and experimenting with different felting techniques. Come with your own ideas or be inspired on the day.

**Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2017 10.30 – 1.30pm £30pp** **Hawkmoon Hares** Create your own magical March hare using a range of different wools and using the needle felting technique & finishing it off with a little bead charm. This will be a relaxing, fun & creative workshop.



**Pottery Design and Decoration. Six week course on Sundays**  
**February 5, 12, 19, 26 and 5, 12 of March 2017 10.30 – 1.30pm £120pp for 6 weeks** Design and make your own projects using your preferred method of hand building or throwing. Decorating techniques will include slip trailing, sgraffito, painting, texture, wax resist. Finished pieces will be fired and available to take home from the shop. 6 places



**Learn to Crochet! Four relaxed and fun crochet sessions with our expert tutor Pam Barnell.** Ideal for absolute beginners or as a refresher. **Mondays 13, 20, 27 February and 6 March 2017 1pm – 4pm.** The 1<sup>st</sup> session is essential for absolute beginners, or for those who want to refresh their skills. You will make something to take home in each session. **Book the course of 4 for £52 or book at £15 per session** - all materials and handouts are included. Session 1 Crochet a flower garland, Session 2 crochet a pencil pot cover, Session 3 begin a small crochet bag or scarf, Session 4 crochet some bunting and a round coaster.

**Evening Pottery 6-week class starting Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2017 – 9.30pm £100 pp 8 places.** Come and join local artist Fiona Radford for a 6-week pottery evening class. No previous experience required and all levels of ability are welcome. She will teach you how to hand build pots and ornaments. You will learn how to hand make pottery using different methods, including coiling and slab building, and decorative techniques such as slip glazing and sgraffito. This is a hands on practical course. Fiona will support and guide you while you make pieces of your own choice, and at your own speed. Make a lamp base, bowl, jug, animal ornament, tiles or a model of your pet! Enjoy our new purpose built studio and learn in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere. Tea and coffee and all materials and tools are provided. Bring an apron and closed toed shoes for safety. When finished, glazed and fired your creations can be picked up from the shop.

**Children's Fun Pottery sessions - Making pinch pot monsters in our pottery Saturday afternoon January 14<sup>th</sup> 2017 1.00 – 2.30pm £5 per person.** This class is in addition to the morning session which is now fully booked. Includes firing of pots, which can be collected from the Alford Craft Market Shop. Limited to 10 places



**Throwing on the potters wheel - pottery taster session Friday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2017 10.30 – 1.00** Come and spend a morning learning how to throw a pot on the potters wheel. A great opportunity to see if you like getting your hands mucky! **£25pp, which includes firing and glazing of your finished items.** Limited 4 places

**A series of Adult marbling workshops with Craig Joubert of Marble Art Originals. No experience in marbling is needed.**

**Design unique marbled cotton patches** for patchwork for cushion covers or small quilts. Including stencilling techniques. **Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2017 10.30am – 12.30pm £25pp** includes all equipment and materials.



**Join us for a workshop designing eye-catching satin for making marbled lampshades. Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2017 10.30 – 12.30pm £25pp** includes all equipment and materials.



**A fused glass workshop with Matt Sorrell – Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2017 10.30 – 1.30pm £45 pp – Make a sailboat light catcher.** Painting on glass with liquid enamels and layering cut glass to form shapes like a sailboat. Includes all equipment and materials. Limited to 6 places. Your light catcher will be created by painting a liquid enamel compatible paint on to a piece of glass, then shapes laid on top. Then your piece will be fired to roughly 810c in our glass-fusing kiln and afterwards will be available for collection at the Alford Craft Market Shop.



**Create either a flower, or a row of sail boats, or a beach hut light catcher out of fused bulls eye glass Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2017 10.30 – 1.30 and 2.30 – 5.30PM** limited availability. You will learn how to cut the glass, and can create your own unique piece 6 x 4 inches **£40pp for the sailboats or flower, or a beach hut 6 x 4 inches £45pp.** Includes all equipment and materials.

**Create your own one of a kind marbled silk scarf. Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2017 10.30 – 12.30pm £25pp** includes all equipment and materials.



**Get to know your sewing machine better on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2017 10.30 – 12.30 £5pp.** Get your sewing machine out of that cupboard! Bring your machine and manual, attachments box, thread & bobbins and learn to use all those stitches you've never tried! De-fluff your machine & learn how to service it. Find out about stitch sizes, types of needles and make samples with tutors Annie Moss and Margaret Fulwood.



**Acrylic Painting Workshop – beginners and intermediates 21st January 2017 10:30 to 4:30 £25pp** (coffee & tea provided). Try your hand at painting with acrylics – bright, vibrant & versatile they can be used in a number of different ways to create a 'watercolour' or 'oil' effect and can be over painted almost straight away making it very easy to correct any mistakes or improve things you don't like! How about painting your pet, house or favourite landscape - bring photos with you. You'll also need: Brushes suitable for acrylic paints – one large (e.g. number 12), one medium (e.g. number 6) and one small/fine for detail work. Acrylic paper or canvas/canvas board. If you use paper either a gummed pad or a sheet taped to a board. Rough/cheap paper for sketching/testing mixed colours & a soft pencil (2B) or charcoal.
