

Mosaic Xmas Trees with Fiona Gurney of Box of Frogs Mosaics on Friday 30th November 2018 10.30 – 3.30 £53pp. Make a decorative mosaic tree – plant it in a pot at the side of your door or amongst the leaves in the garden! Colourful tiles, glass beads & shiny details – develop your own design or use a template. Weatherproof and suitable to be outside you will take home a finished grouted tree.



Wet felted fairies with textile artist Karen Lane on Saturday 1st December 18 10.30 – 3.30pm £40pp includes all materials. These felted fairies look great on top of the Christmas tree. They are fun to make involving both wet and needle felting techniques. The workshop is suitable for all abilities.

Monthly quilting club with quilter Sue Frecklington on the first Wednesday of each month 10.30- 3.30 £13pp. Make a pieced quilt with expert help from Sue. Bring your own materials. You can bring your own machine or use one of ours. Includes, tea, coffee & biscuits – please bring a packed lunch. Proceeds in aid of Alternating Hemiplegia of Childhood (AHC)

Pottery Design & Decoration. Choose a 6 week course Sundays or Thursday mornings. Starting on Sunday 28th October or Thursday 1st November 2018 10.30 – 1.30 6 places each course £120pp.

Design and make your own projects using your preferred method of hand building or throwing. Decorating techniques will include slip trailing, sgraffito, painting, texture, wax resist. One session will be a Raku firing, and there will be one free catch-up day at the end for anyone who misses a class, (sorry, no refunds on other days missed).

Marble 2 ceramic baubles for your Xmas tree with Jess Trevett on Saturday 3rd November 2018 10.30 – 12.30 £33pp. Create a selection of A6 marbled papers to perfect your technique before using your new found skill on your two ceramic baubles. Baubles and papers to be collected about a week later after drying. All materials and papers provided.



Make your own fused glass Christmas decorations or presents using clear glass, coloured glass and frits with Matt Sorrell on **Sunday 11th November 2018 2.30 – 5pm. Make 3 hangers for £28 or 5 hangers for £44.** 5" x 2" Includes all materials and use of equipment. Matt will fuse your creations in our kiln and they will be ready to collect in about a week. We can post to you for a small extra charge. Suitable for adults and accompanied children over 8 years.



Taster session Throwing on the Potters Wheel with Pris McGirr Tuesday 6th November 2018 10.30 – 1.30pm. £30pp. Includes clay, glazes and firing. Learn how to work with clay, centre a piece of clay and throw a bowl(s).



Make delicate wet felted flowers with textile artist Karen Lane Saturday 10th November 2018 10.30 – 1pm £25pp. During this workshop you will learn to make beautiful, delicate wet felted flowers using soft Merino wool fibres and Tussah silk. Flowers can have 'stalks' added, or be made into brooches to pin to hats, coats or bags. All materials & equipment provided. 8 places



Ceramic animal, pet or fantasy creature heads sculpture workshop with Fiona Radford on Saturday 10th November 2018 1pm – 4pm. Suitable for all abilities – ages 14+ **£40pp** includes clay, glazes and firings – 8 places. Bring images or photos to inspire you. Your head will be dried, glazed and fired for you and will be ready about 3 weeks after the workshop.



Join herbalist Ali English (BSc Hons Med Herb) **for a workshop on spice cabinet medicine** using commonly available ingredients easily found in supermarkets & greengrocers to make medicines to relieve common health issues. **Monday 12th November 2018 10.30 – 12.30pm £23 per person.** Please bring your own jars & bottles. All other materials will be provided.



Make a big Xmas stocking with Sandy Loosley on Friday 16 November 2018 10.30 – 1.30 £35 per person. Continuing on the festive theme let's make a Xmas stocking measuring 8" x 21". Bring ½ metre of main fabric & ½ metre of lining fabric (preferably co-ordinating). 100% cotton would be best. You can appliqué or quilt as you wish. Fusible fleece will be provided at the class. Bring your own sewing machine and sewing kit. Limited to 4 places.

A relaxed one day workshop with maker of hooked rag rugs Angela King on Saturday 17th November 2018 10.30 – 3.30pm £30pp. Work on a small piece and learn the different techniques – peg and snip rug tuition also introduced. Limited to 8 places. All materials and use of tools included.



Have a go at making your own beads by melting glass in a hot flame – warning it is highly addictive!. With tutor Pris McGirr on Saturday 17th November 2018 10.30 – 2.30pm. £40pp – includes all the beads you make during the session, fired in the kiln and cleaned ready for you to pick up the following week (or we can post for a small extra charge). You will learn how to make big hole beads to thread on a chain, ribbon or Pandora bracelet as well as pendants and smaller spacer beads. For safety reasons please tie back long hair and wear cotton clothes. Age 16 and over, 5 places.



Improvers class Saturday 15th December 2018 10.30 – 2.30 £40pp Not for beginners but if you have done a taster session and want to improve your skill and learn new techniques, this is the class for you. You will make shaped beads using standard sized mandrels, brass presses & hand shaping, adding flower murrini, and fine stringer and dot decoration. 5 places.
